### CHERI is moving now!

- After 14 years in the lab, CHERI is now mature
  - Govt and industry invested ~ £300m to develop CHERI

- Government are demanding memory safety
  - New requirement in UK govt procurement
  - White House publicly supporting it and putting responsibility in the hands of the high-tech industry

- · Leading companies are getting involved
  - Processors are now available
  - Software is being adapted

### Why a CHERI Alliance?

- CHERI cannot just be a specification
- Need to go further
  - Promotion of security (and CHERI in particular)
  - Technical alignment
    - Make sure it can be implemented efficiently
    - Manage different "flavors" of CHERI
  - Ensure compliance
  - Demonstrate industry adoption
  - Manage the communication / branding
  - Educate, support community

- Develop and promote the CHERI specification
- Support CHERI adoption in open-source software
- Focus on efficient implementation and optimization
- Drive standardization, other organizations
- Establish best practices, guidelines, and implementation methodologies

#### Marketing

- Advocate for the adoption of CHERI by industry players
- Raise awareness about importance of robust security
- Educate industry stakeholders and regulatory bodies
- Promote and protect the CHERI brand

#### Compliance

- Develop a compliance program
- Manage testing process
- Manage branding and promotion of compliant products

- Foster collaboration among Alliance members
- Facilitate networking opportunities, conferences, and workshops
- Collaborate with related / complementary security initiatives
- Host SW repositories
- · Promote HW reference models



### An independent entity

- ISA-agnostic
  - CHERI could be added to Arm, Intel, MIPS, RISC-V, ...
- Country-agnostic
  - Initially driven by UK/US, but security is not country-dependent
- · Not just one company
  - · Need broad industry adoption
  - · Need a community
- Need to own and control CHERI brand
